



# FOG & MIST POLICY

## **KNOW THE POLICY**

A fog/mist policy has been put in place to ensure the safety of golfers and staff during period of low visibility. The Head Green keeper or in his absence a designated staff member is responsible for implementing the policy and advising club management of the decision.

## **CLOSING THE COURSE**

Play will not commence if the 150 yard marker on the 1st hole is not visible from the 1st tee. Signage is to be placed on both 1st and 10th tees and players currently on course to be advised of the decision.

## **YOUR RESPONSIBILITY**

If you feel that you are in danger during play due to fog and could cause injury to others, you must cease play, mark your ball and return to the clubhouse until it is safe to resume play.

## **RESUMPTION OF PLAY**

Conditions will be continually assessed and the decision to re-commence play will be made by the Head Green keeper or in his absence a designated staff member. Upon resumption, players are responsible to ensure the group in front is not within hitting range before playing.
